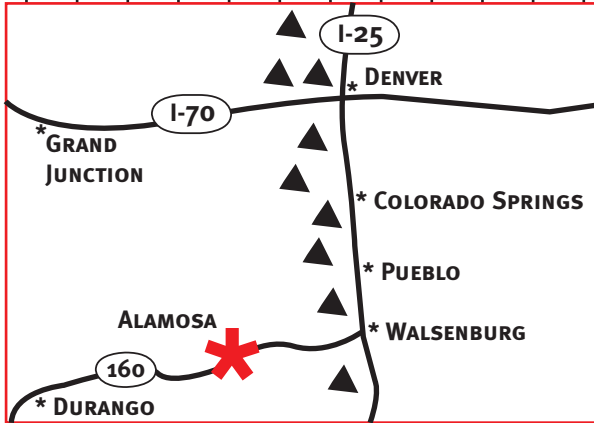


**WHERE IS ADAMS STATE COLLEGE

Participants in this workshop will bring a vocal piece with them and work on sight-reading skills, pitch matching and performing a solo in preparation for all-state choir auditions. Participants will be assigned a 15 minute individual session prior to the Arts Extravaganza.

Piano Master Class

Participants in this workshop will work with Dr. William Lipke, ASC's piano professor, in a low key learning environment. Participants should come with one or two solos and bring their music scores.
